To initiate your visa process, send the following items to the Church Travel Office. **Please deliver the following items as soon as possible.**

- 2 Notarized copies of birth certificate
- 1 Notarized Original police clearance certificate
- 2 Notarized copies of school certificates
- 2 Notarized copies of CES certificates
- 2 Notarized copies of Melchizedek priesthood ordination certificates for elders
- 4 passport size photos (white background)
- 1 Ministerial Certificate [please find attached]
- 1 Missionary Questionnaire [please find attached]
- 2 Original radiological report
- 2 Notarized radiological Report [please find attached]
- Curriculum Vitae [please find attached]

Color Photographs

- You must obtain 4 color passport type photos with a white background from a professional passport photo service to apply for your visa. No photocopies or homemade photos of any kind will be accepted. Wear missionary attire and follow missionary grooming standards.

Radiological Report

- Have your doctor fill out, sign, and stamp the 2 enclosed radiological reports to certify that you are free from active pulmonary tuberculosis. A doctor's business card may be attached if there is no stamp.
- Please have your radiologist provide two originals radiological report and staple one to each radiological report provided in your visa packet. Photocopies are not acceptable.
- The reports must be dated no earlier than six months before arrival in Zimbabwe.
- If the doctor chooses to use other forms, please attach them to the reports and have the doctor sign both forms.

Ministerial Certificate

- Sign the enclosed ministerial certificate.

Curriculum Vitae

- Complete the enclosed curriculum vitae. Under the section Special Expertise list as many church and community activities as you can.

Missionary Questionnaire

- Complete the enclosed missionary questionnaire.
